PROCESSION INTO JERUSALEM – Matthew 21: 6-11

Jerusalem was stirred as Jesus entered the city. "Who is this?" they asked. The crowds replied, "It's Jesus, the Prophet from Nazareth in Galilee."

3 CHRIST'S LAST SUPPER – Mark 14:17-25, Mark 14:29-31, John 13:3-9

As Jesus and the disciples sat around a table, He pointed out that one would betray Him. Distressed, each asked, "I'm not the one, am I?"

4 IN THE GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE – Luke 22: 39-51

At Gethsemane, Jesus told the disciples to pray so that they would not be overcome by temptation, then He walked away and prayed, "Father, if You are willing, please take this cup of suffering away from Me. Yet I want Your will, not Mine."

A mob approached, led by Judas, one of His twelve disciples. Judas came up to Jesus and greeted Him with a kiss. Jesus said, "Judas, how can you betray Me, the Son of Man, with a kiss?"

6 PILATE'S JUDGEMENT – Matthew 27:11-32

After being found guilty by the Sanhedrin, Jesus stood before Pilate, the Roman Governor, who asked, "Are you the King of the Jews?" Jesus replied, "Yes, it is as you say."

Pilate asked the crowd, "What crime did He commit?" The crowd just roared louder, "Crucify Him!"

6 CHRIST'S CRUCIFIXION & DEATH – Luke 23:32-43, Luke 23:50-56, John 19:25-30

Two criminals were led out with Jesus to a place where all three were crucified—He on the center cross, the criminals on either side.


Jesus said, "Father, forgive these people, because they don't know what they are doing."

THE RESURRECTION OF CHRIST – *Matthew 27:62-66, Matthew 28:2-4, Luke 24:1-10, Luke 24:46-53*

The priests remembered that Jesus had said He would be raised from the dead after three days. They had asked Pilate to seal the tomb until the third day to prevent Jesus' disciples from stealing His body and saying He came back to life. Pilate sent guards to seal and protect the tomb.

Early on Sunday morning there was suddenly a great earthquake because an angel of the Lord came down from heaven and rolled aside the stone.

Forces of evil are personified in several Risen Experience scenes, helping the viewer better understand the cosmic nature of this conflict as described in Scripture. Also, the final scene compresses events that actually spanned 40 days. We encourage you to study the Bible and discover for yourself the life-changing significance of Christ's time here on earth.
